(a)	Application for Tree Works: 23/00039/ATP For: Pruning of Copper Beeches T2 & T4 & Silver Birch T3 on TPO/28/88. The property (Grade 2 listed) has been re-thatched and with no maintenance to the trees for many years, they are overhanging the roof which will result in damage from lack of sunlight, moss, etc. Copper Beech T4 is severely over-hanging the next door property and both Copper Beeches (T2 & T4) are overhanging the road quite significantly, dragging on passing buses, etc. Both trees require some good practice general maintenance and without it, I suspect the life of both trees will be more limited. This is pruning work to reduce the overall size of T3 (Silver Birch), T2 (Copper Beech) and T4 (Copper Beech) by 20% as recommended by a local tree surgeon and in addition remove overhanging/dangerous branches that are impacting the highway.
