**117/22 Planning application: 22/02814/APP**

For: Extension and replacement of existing roof with new hip to gable roof line, Velux dormer roof lights to front and rear elevations, single storey side and rear extensions and widen existing crossover to accommodate additional parking  
At: 28 Warners Road, Newton Longville

Resolved no objection to application, however if application is approved, conditions should be imposed to control parking both during construction and ongoing, noise to neighbouring properties, hours of construction work. Concern expressed over time to complete any development, therefore only a short period should be allowed for work to be completed following start of construction.

For: New agricultural building for storing straw

At: Land To The Rear Of Yew Tree Close

This will be visible from the public highway despite what is claimed in the application. It is likely to be seen from some properties in Yew Tree Close, Westbrook End and Lower End.
